1. Welcome and introductions (Redacted)

Redacted welcomed attendees.



2. Review of Minutes and Actions (Redacted)

Minutes of the last meeting held on 4 June 2018 were reviewed by members and agreed as an accurate record.

Members reviewed the open actions table and agreed that actions A117, A118, A121, A122, A123 and A124 could be closed - *please refer to the previous minutes for any detail on these actions*.

3. Phase Step 1 Programme Board Update and Key Risks (Redacted)

Redacted provided members with a status update using the slidedeck provided and the following points were noted:

- <u>Redacted</u> provided members with an overview of the key milestones based on the Plan On a Page (POAP);
- Redacted also shared a separate supplier scorecard setting out progress against the key contractual milestones for GP system suppliers to be included in the future Board updates going forward;
- the DDC milestone set out in the POAP, has slipped by a month in order to mitigate 2 key risks set out on slide 5;
- Integration testing of the DDC solution with GP System Suppliers is due to start next week, ahead of schedule;
- following the Board's agreement to proceed with Step 2 of Phase 1, elaboration workshops have begun with system suppliers. Following completion of the workshops, a specification will be issued by the end of July which will allow system suppliers to produce design documentation and start development work;
- the changes to CQRS are now complete and have gone live;
- communications planning activity is in progress as part of the transition work. Key messages are in the process of being agreed with the profession. Various channels, including the website, will be used to publicise the changes;
- a new target operating model is being produced which will set out the new processes which the business team will need to adopt as part of the new service.

4. Phase 2 Status Programme Board Update and Key Risks (Redacted)

Redacted and Redacted provided members with a status update on Phase 2 and the following points were noted:



- Redacted provided an overview on the key milestones based on the Standard GP Dataset POAP;
- one of the key areas of work on Phase 2 is approval of the Full Business Case which will be reviewed by various stakeholders including, Board members and NHS England before submission to TDIB for approval on 21 September;
- Another key area of work is approval of the dataset as an Information Standards Notice (ISN);
- initial engagement with the GP Professions now complete and preparation for a process of formal consultation with the profession is underway;
- Redacted reported that further work has been undertaken to ensure and demonstrate that only the minimum amount of data necessary for secondary uses will be collected. Analysis has been undertaken to look at the best way of doing this, along with implications of the noncollection of data items. These proposals have yet to be discussed with Redacted and Redacted and Redacted will seek to bring a set of proposals to this Board in the future;
- engagement sessions have been held with all system suppliers to test their understanding of what is required and to work with them to prototype their capability to map the data to a standard structure under the ISN;
- Redacted suggested that Redacted CCG Birmingham would be a good exemplar to work with. Redacted agreed to discuss this with Redacted;
- the contract has now been let for the re-identification service and successful supplier is Privtaar;
- <u>Redacted</u> reported on the approach to developing the communications strategy. <u>Redacted</u> commented on the important of briefing senior colleagues such as, <u>Redacted</u>, <u>Redacted</u>
 <u>Redacted</u> and <u>Redacted</u> going forward, along with the likely need to brief the Secretary of State ahead of more public facing activity;
- Redacted reported that shortfall based on the Redacted capital forecast is £374K(slide 11).
 Redacted was confident that further savings could be found to further reduce the gap, and this will be monitored closely over the coming months;
- Redacted commented that the NHS England POSA has been approved by FCAP and is currently with NHS England for signature.

5. New Governance Structure (Redacted)

Redacted took Board members though the slidedeck setting out the new governance structure and the following points were noted:

• for background, Redacted explained that this work arose from acknowledgement at a senior level that there was a logistical challenge in operating effectively under the existing



governance structure. These changes seek to simplify the structure to ensure attendance by key members at meetings to facilitate timely decision making;

- the new GP Data Programme Board will cover the following programmes:
 - o GP Connect
 - o GP Data for Secondary Uses
 - o SNOMED
 - GP Appointments Data in Support of Winter Pressures
- members were content with the proposal for this Board to continue as the GP Data for Secondary Uses Delivery Board, which would be responsible for delivery of phase 1 and phase 2 of the GP Data for Secondary Uses programme;
- Redacted asked members for comments on the draft Terms of Reference;
- Redacted commented on the lack of a service user representative.
