Purpose of the paper:	To update the Board on the publication of the National Information Board's Framework for Action and its implications for the HSCIC
Risks and Issues:	<p>The National Information Board is intended to bring a collective strategic approach to the commissioning of health and care informatics services. As such it is critical to the HSCIC.</p> <p>The Framework generally, and more specifically, many of the recommendations have implications for the HSCIC in terms of commitments and delivery. Given the timing of the publication of this Framework, we have not yet had the opportunity to assess the implications and risks in the round. This will be addressed as part of the business planning round.</p>
Patient/Public Interest:	<p>There is a public interest in this paper because this document will inform the future direction for data and information supporting the transformation of health and care services.</p> <p>It is worth noting also that the document highlights the importance of public trust and confidence in the way that sensitive data is handled by the health and care system.</p>
