#### **HSCIC Statistical Publications**

#### **Purpose**

1. This paper describes HSCIC Official Statistics publications in April and May 2013, and web hits and media coverage for Official Statistics publications in March 2013.

#### **Background to HSCIC Official Statistics**

- 2. The HSCIC is responsible for the publication of 99 series of Official Statistics. Of these, 38 series are designated as National Statistics, meaning that the UK Statistics Authority (UKSA) recognises them as being compliant with the Code of Practice of Official Statistics (but note that some National Statistics have retained this designation on a legacy basis from before the current regulatory framework was introduced in April 2008 and formal reassessment by the Authority is yet to be completed).
- 3. The HSCIC is required to notify the National Statistician of any plans to cease publication of any Official Statistics we produce or of our intention to make any substantial changes in their scope which "could potentially impact adversely on the quality, comparability or coverage of the statistics"
- 4. Most series of Official Statistics are published annually, or more frequently, and it is generally the case that each edition is broadly similar in content. It has been noted below where a publication is not an edition of a regularly repeating series or where there are substantial changes to the content of repeating series of statistics.
- 5. Few series of Official Statistics can be expected to remain static over time, as we seek to publish outputs which meet the changing needs of our users, continually to improve their quality and utility, and as we respond to changes in the administrative and management data sources from which many of our Official Statistics are derived.
- 6. "Experimental statistics" are new Official Statistics that are under-going evaluation. A key part of the "Experimental statistics" label is user engagement in the evaluation of those statistics. The HSCIC invites readers to comment on these publications, which will help inform the next reports.
- 7. Official Statistics which are designated as National Statistics are annotated below with '[NS]'.

## Media Coverage and Web Hits for Statistical Publications - March 2013

#### Media coverage

- The Provisional Monthly HES publication, special topic: tooth decay helped the HES team record a circulation of 27.1 million their highest level of circulation achieved from any publication over the last 12 months and boosted particularly by extensive BBC News channels coverage.
- The embargoed publication of the Sudden Arrhythmic Death Syndrome Audit generated keen interest
  from Sky News Radio and BBC Breakfast TV news, but due to logistical difficulties recording interviews
  with the Clinical Lead, this did not develop into actual broadcast coverage. However, the press notice
  went on to achieve significantly higher AVE and circulation results than recorded for the previous SADs
  audit, published in March 2012.

# Positive/negative coverage

• Positive coverage remains strong, and correct citation is now close to level of pre-HSCIC before our legal name was adopted.
